2009 – 2010 Team Tournament Rules

1. **Eligibility:** This tournament is certified under the rules, regulations, and auspices of the United States Bowling Congress. Adult entrants must be in good standing of the USBC and the Greater Dayton USBC Association. Bowlers must present current membership card to tournament officials prior to bowling.
 - a. Any individual wishing to compete in a GDUSBCA event as an unattached member will be required to purchase membership 30 days prior to the date the player participates in the tournament.
 - b. Members who are eligible for another association championship tournament must have bowled a minimum of 21 games in a GDUSBCA sanctioned league in the 2008-2009 season or current year to be able to participate in the GDUSBCA city tournaments.
2. **Cost:** \$125.00 per team (\$25.00 per person) **\$150.00 per team (\$30.00 per person)** as a walk-in.
 - a. Walk-Ins will be accepted subject to lane availability. Walk-in entries will be accepted up to 15 minutes prior to start of next shift. A walk-in is defined as an entry being submitted the day of the actual event bowled and will be assessed a \$5.00 fee per bowler.
 - b. No entry fees will be refunded once the entry has been scheduled
 - c. No checks the day of the tournament
3. **All Events:** The \$5.00 All Events fee must be paid with your first team entry.
4. **Handicap:** Handicap will be 90% of 1100
5. **Entering Average:** To be eligible for handicap, bowlers must have a USBC average for 21 games or more for the 2008/09 season. The highest average will be used from the 2008/09 season. If a bowler's current average for 21 or more games as of November 1, 2009 is ten pins or higher than his/her 2008/09 average, the current average must be used. Any bowler not having a 2008/09 USBC average may use his/her highest league average as of November 1, 2009 for 21 games or more. If no average meeting the previous criteria, then bowler will use entering average of 220.
 - a. Falsifying of average may lead to the disqualification of the bowler, forfeiture of fees, and possible suspension.
 - b. Bowlers with an average only from a sport shot league will be readjusted based on USBC recommendations.
 - c. USBC rules 319A, 319C, 319E, and 322 are in effect and will be enforced.
 - d. All errors must be reported within 48 hours of competition. The GDUSBCA phone number is (937)222-2695.
6. **Prize Winnings:** Need not be reported
7. **Lane Assignment/Tardy Bowlers:**
 - a. Bowlers will bowl on the date and time of their choice unless otherwise notified
 - b. Lane assignments will be made randomly and bowlers must bowl on the lanes assigned. Teams wishing to cross must submit entries at the same time in the same envelope.
 - c. The tournament will have a maximum of 24 lanes per shift.
 - d. Any bowler arriving late shall receive zero for frames missed and shall begin play with the frame being bowled.
8. **Champions:** Champions will be crowned and presented a suitable award. Multiple champions will receive one award properly inscribed. All champions will receive a paid entry into the next GDUSBCA event in the category won.
9. **Prize Fund:** 100% of prize fund will be returned. Additional prize money may be added from walk-in fees, brackets, etc. Prize ratio for team event will be 1 in 5 and for All Events 1 in 10 entries.
10. **Multiple Team Entry:** Bowlers may bowl and receive prizes multiple times. Two members of a five man team must be changed for that team to be considered a separate team. Bowlers who are entered as members of more than one team will use their first team event score to determine All Events score.
11. **Substitutes:** Substitutes will be permitted as long as the multiple participation (see rule #10) is followed. The substitute must bowl in the position vacated by the original entrant. Substitutes will receive all prize monies awarded and is not required to reimburse the original entrant for the entry fee(s) paid. There will be no refunds.
