2009 – 2010 Youth Team Tournament Rules

1. **Administration:** The Greater Dayton United States Bowling Congress Association will administer this tournament.
2. **Cost:** \$48.00 per team (\$12.00 per person)
 - a. Walk-Ins will be accepted subject to lane availability. Walk-in entries will be accepted up to 15 minutes prior to start of next shift. A walk-in is defined as an entry being submitted the day of the actual event bowled.
3. **All Events:** The \$3.00 All Events fee must have been paid with your first City Tournament entry. All Events is an individual tournament using the total of the first series bowled in the City Doubles, Singles and Team. Scholarships will be awarded to the champion in each division. The number of entries, in each division, will determine the amount of the scholarship.
4. **Eligibility:** This tournament is open to all youth bowlers who are current Greater Dayton USBC members.
5. **Teams:** Four (4) members per team. They may be comprised of all boy, all girl or mixed (boy and girl). Oldest team member determines the division.
6. **Participation:** Bowlers may bowl more than one time, but at least two teammates must be changed.
7. **Handicap:** Team handicap will be 90% of 860 (all divisions).
8. **Average:** Average used will be the current season average for each bowler. **A CURRENT STANDING SHEET WITH AVERAGE IS REQUIRED FOR ENTRY.** If no current average exists the highest average from the 2008-2009 GDUSBC Average Book will be used. If the bowler has no book average for the 2008-2009 season, they must bowl scratch.
9. **Format for the Tournament:**
 - a. This tournament will be conducted in four divisions: Bantam, Prep, Junior and Major.
 - b. There will be three categories for each division: Boy, Girl and Mixed (boy and girl).
 - i. The Bantam division will not have categories and will all be competing in one division.
 - ii. The oldest team member determines the division in which you will bowl.
 - c. There is an OPTIONAL scratch division for all divisions and categories.
 - d. All divisions will bowl three (3) games.
 - e. Winners will be determined by total pins including handicap.
 - f. Scoring errors: Scoring errors must be reported to the tournament office within one half hour of the completion of the shift bowled in which the error occurred.
 - g. Tardy Teams: Teams and/or bowlers must start in the frame being bowled at the time they arrive in the tournament office. Teams and/or bowlers will receive zero (0) pins for all frames missed. No absentee scores are permitted.
 - h. In case of ties, duplicate awards will be presented.
10. **Rules:** The tournament rules above and USBC rules will govern this tournament and will be strictly enforced. All rules not covered above will be determined by the tournament committee.
11. **Awards:** We will present awards based on one award for every five entries in each division up to a maximum of ten awards. Awards will be presented at the annual awards banquet.
