2011 Bunny Shoot Tournament Rules

1. **Administration:** The Greater Dayton United States Bowling Congress Association Youth Leaders will administer this tournament.
2. **Cost:** \$60 per two person team
 - a. Walk-Ins will be accepted subject to lane availability. Walk-in entries will be accepted until 7:45 pm. A walk-in is defined as an entry being submitted the day of the actual event bowled.
3. **Eligibility:** This tournament is open to all ADULT bowlers who are current Greater Dayton USBC members.
4. **Teams:** Two (2) members per team. They may be comprised of all men, all women or mixed.
5. **Participation:** Bowlers may bowl one time – there is only one shift offered for this tournament.
6. **Handicap:** Team handicap will be 90% of 430.
7. **Average:** Entrants will use their highest 2009-2010 sanctioned average of 21 games or more (GDUSBC average book will be used). If no average can be verified, then the bowler must bowl scratch (215 average).
8. **Format for the Tournament:**
 - a. This tournament will be conducted in one division. Teams may consist of men, women, or mixed. Current GDUSBC youth members are ineligible to bowl as money is offered as a reward.
 - b. This tournament is a 9-pin no-tap, Baker format. A 9 count on the first ball counts as a strike. One bowler on each team will bowl odd frames, with the other team member bowling even frames. Bowlers must change lineup (odds and evens) each game.
 - c. Teams must consist of 2 bowlers. No blind scores allowed. If a team is missing a bowler, then a zero must be taken for absent frames.
 - d. Teams will bowl six (6) games, alternating lanes on the same pair upon completion of each game. Team lineup must alternate after each game, but can not be changed during a game. Following round one, match play will begin with the top 16 teams advancing through one game elimination until the last team remains. One lane courtesy is required throughout all rounds of the tournament. A maximum of 6 teams will be present per pair of lanes.
 - e. Winners will be determined by total pins including handicap.
 - f. Scoring errors: Scoring errors must be reported to the tournament office within one half hour of the completion of the shift bowled in which the error occurred.
 - g. Tardy Teams: Teams and/or bowlers must start in the frame being bowled at the time they arrive in the tournament office. Teams and/or bowlers will receive zero (0) pins for all frames missed. No absentee scores are permitted.
 - h. Prize fund is based on a full field of 60 teams. Should there be less than 60 teams, the prize fund will be adjusted accordingly.
 - i. In the event of a tie, the teams tied will split the respective position money evenly. If there is a tie for lowest cash award position, the two teams will share the lowest cash position prize fund. If there is a tie for first place, then a one-game roll-off with handicap will be bowled by the teams tied to determine tournament champion.
9. **Rules:** The tournament rules above and USBC rules will govern this tournament and will be strictly enforced. All rules not covered above will be determined by the tournament committee.
10. **Awards:** Prize money will be awarded to the top 8 teams.
