## **2010 – 2011 Youth Team Tournament Rules**

1. **Administration:** The Greater Dayton United States Bowling Congress Association will administer this tournament.
2. **Cost:** \$32.00 per team (\$16.00 per person)
  - a. Walk-Ins will be accepted subject to lane availability. Walk-in entries will be accepted up to 15 minutes prior to start of next shift. A walk-in is defined as an entry being submitted the day of the actual event bowled.
3. **Eligibility:** This tournament is open to all youth bowlers who are current Greater Dayton USBC members.
4. **Teams:** Two (2) members per team. They may be comprised of all boy, all girl or mixed (boy and girl). Team Average determines division.
5. **Participation:** Bowlers may bowl more than one time, but at least one teammate must be changed.
6. **Handicap:** Team handicap will be 90% of 215.
7. **Average:** Average used will be the current 2010-2011 season average (min. 9 games). If the minimum has not been reached, the highest average will be taken from the 2009-2010 Greater Dayton USBC Youth Average Book. If no averages exist, the bowlers will be bowling scratch. **BOWLER RESPONSIBLE FOR BRINGING CURRENT STANDING SHEET FROM HOME CENTER.**
8. **Format for the Tournament:**
  - a. This tournament will be conducted in two divisions based on total average of team.
  - b. Winners will be determined by total pins including bonus pins and handicap.
  - c. Scoring errors: Scoring errors must be reported to the tournament office within one half hour of the completion of the shift bowled in which the error occurred.
  - d. Tardy Teams: Teams and/or bowlers must start in the frame being bowled at the time they arrive in the tournament office. Teams and/or bowlers will receive zero (0) pins for all frames missed. No absentee scores are permitted.
  - e. In case of ties, duplicate awards will be presented.
9. **Rules:** The tournament rules above and USBC rules will govern this tournament and will be strictly enforced. All rules not covered above will be determined by the tournament committee.
10. **Awards:** We will present awards based on one award for every five entries in each division up to a maximum of ten awards. Awards will be presented at the annual awards banquet.
11. **Dress Code:** All Greater Dayton USBC (GDUSBC) youth bowlers are expected to use good judgment and wear suitable attire during tournament play. Clothing choices must be presentable and non-offensive to other bowlers or spectators. Examples of prohibited attire include but are not limited to: short shorts or any shorts that are more than 4 inches above the knee, pants hanging below the waist, display of underwear and/or body parts, hats, low-cut shirts, see-through clothing, T-shirts with alcohol or cigarette advertisements, inappropriate language, gestures, or gambling. GDUSBC bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by a GDUSBC Tournament Official. Tournament Official's decision will be final. Failure to comply with any dress code rule will result in a verbal warning and apparel change (if applicable). Second offense will result in offender being asked to leave the center for the day, disqualification from the tournament and forfeiture of any entry fees submitted.
