2011-2012 ADULT/ YOUTH TOURNAMENT RULES

1. **ADMINISTRATION:** The Greater Dayton USBC will administer this tournament.
2. **PRE-PAID ENTRIES:** The closing date for pre-paid entries for the September 18th squads is September 14th. The closing date for pre-paid entries for the October 2nd squads is September 28th. All entries will be treated as walk-in entries after those dates.
3. **WALK-IN ENTRIES: WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR ALL SQUADS SUBJECT TO LANE AVAILABILITY. ALL WALK-IN ENTRIES MUST BE TURNED IN TO THE CHECK IN OFFICE 15 MINUTES BEFORE THE SQUAD STARTS.**
4. **TEAMS:** This tournament is open to all youth bowlers who are current Greater Dayton USBC members. Adults who do not have a USBC card must purchase a card before their shift times. Cards will be available at the tournament.
5. **PARTICIPATION:** Bowlers may participate as many times as they wish. However no two bowlers may bowl together more than once.
6. **SUBSTITUTIONS:** Substitutions must be made 30 minutes prior the scheduled shift time.
7. **HANDICAP:** 90% of 430(all divisions).
8. **AVERAGES:** Average used will be the highest average from the 2010-2011 Greater Dayton USBC Average Book. However, if there is no average from the 2010-2011 average book, a 2011 summer league average may be used provided a final standings sheet is turned in with the entry. If the league was a sport condition league, the average will be adjusted according to the rule#202. If no averages exist the bowlers will be bowling scratch (215).
9. **Re-rates:** If the bowlers average in the 2010-2011 GDUSBC Average Book is from a league that is considered a "sport shot, sport condition, tougher condition, or anything more challenging than a classic house pattern", bowler will be re-rated based on USBC rule#202 (rate will be adjusted to 50% of the rate published in the current USBC rate chart)
10. **FORMAT FOR TOURNAMENT:**
 - A. This tournament will be conducted in 4 divisions Bantam, Prep, Junior and Majors. There will be two categories in each division Boys & Girls.
 - B. Number of games for this tournament will be 3 for all divisions.
 - C. Winners will be determined by total pins including handicap.
 - D. Scoring Errors: Errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament office within 30 minutes after the completion of the squad in which the error occurred. The tournament committee disclaims all responsibility for errors unless this rule is strictly followed.
 - E. Tardy Teams or Bowlers: teams and/or bowlers must start in the frame being bowled at the time they arrive at the tournament office. Teams and/or bowlers will receive zero (0) pins for all frames missed. NO ABSENTEE SCORES ARE PERMITTED.
 - F. All games will be bowled on the same pair of lanes barring any mechanical failure.
 - G. In case of ties, duplicate awards will be presented.
11. **ENTRY FORMS:** Entry forms must be COMPLETELY FILLED OUT.
12. All rules not covered above shall be determined or settled by the tournament committee.
13. **AWARDS:** We will present awards based on one for every seven entries in each division up to a maximum of ten awards. Awards will be presented at the annual awards banquet.
14. **Dress Code:** All Greater Dayton USBC (GDUSBC) youth bowlers are expected to use good judgment and wear suitable attire during tournament play. Clothing choices must be presentable and non-offensive to other bowlers or spectators. Examples of prohibited attire include but are not limited to: short shorts or any shorts that are more than 4 inches above the knee, pants hanging below the waist, display of underwear and/or body parts, hats, low-cut shirts, see-through clothing, T-shirts with alcohol or cigarette advertisements, inappropriate language, gestures, or gambling. GDUSBC bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by a GDUSBC Tournament Official. Tournament Official's decision will be final. Failure to comply with any dress code rule will result in a verbal warning and apparel change (if applicable). Second offense will result in offender being asked to leave the center for the day, disqualification from the tournament and forfeiture of any entry fees submitted
15. **CONDUCT:** Tournament Officials may warn or disqualify bowlers for unsportsmanlike or disruptive conduct. There will be a zero tolerance policy for foul language, rude gestures, or abuse of bowling center equipment. Tournament Officials and/or Bowling Center Management may remove any coach or spectator for disruptive conduct and if necessary, suspend them from attending future tournaments.
