2011 - 2012 Youth Singles Tournament Rules

1. **Administration:** The Greater Dayton United States Bowling Congress Association will administer this tournament.
2. **Cost:** \$14.00 – Scratch Division (optional) is \$1.00
 - a. Walk-Ins will be accepted subject to lane availability. Walk-in entries will be accepted up to 15 minutes prior to start of next shift. A walk-in is defined as an entry being submitted the day of the actual event bowled.
3. **All Events:** The \$5.00 All Events fee must have been paid with your first City Tournament entry. All Events is a separate, individual tournament using the total of the first series bowled in the City Doubles, Singles and Team. Scholarships will be awarded to the champion in each division. The number of entries, in each division, will determine the amount of the scholarship.
4. **Eligibility:** This tournament is open to all youth bowlers who are Greater Dayton USBC members and hold a current and valid Standard or Basic Membership card. Membership cards are **REQUIRED** to be shown at check-in.
5. **Participation:** Bowlers may compete in multiple shifts.
6. **Handicap:** Handicap will be 90% of 215 (all divisions).
7. **Averages:** Average used will be the highest average from the 2010-2011 Greater Dayton USBC Youth Average Book. However, if there is no average from the 2010-2011 average book, a 2011 summer league average may be used provided a final standings sheet is turned in with the entry. If the league was a sport shot condition league, the average will be adjusted according to the rule#202. If no averages exist the bowlers will be bowling scratch.
8. **Re-rates:** If the bowlers average in the 2010-2011 GDUSBC Average Book is from a league that is considered a "sport shot, sport condition, tougher condition, or anything more challenging than a classic house pattern," bowler will be re-rated based on USBC rule #202 (rate will be adjusted to 50% of the rate published in the current USBC rate chart).
9. **Format for the Tournament:**
 - a. This tournament will be conducted in 4 divisions: Bantam, Prep, Junior and Major.
 - b. There will be four categories for each division: Boy Handicap and Scratch and Girl Handicap and Scratch.
 - i. The age of the bowler as of 8/1/11 will determine in which division they will compete. Bowlers must compete in their age division.
 - c. All divisions will bowl three (3) games.
 - d. Winners will be determined by total pins including handicap.
 - e. Scoring errors: Scoring errors must be reported to the tournament office within one half hour of the completion of the shift bowled in which the error occurred.
 - f. Tardy Bowlers: Bowlers must start in the frame being bowled at the time they arrive in the tournament office. Teams and/or bowlers will receive zero (0) pins for all frames missed. No absentee scores are permitted.
 - g. In case of ties, duplicate awards will be presented.
10. **Entry Forms:** Entry forms must be COMPLETELY FILLED OUT.
11. **Rules:** The tournament rules above and USBC rules will govern this tournament and will be strictly enforced. All rules not covered above will be determined by the tournament committee.
12. **Awards:** We will present awards based on one award for every seven entries in each division up to a maximum of ten awards. Awards will be presented at the annual awards banquet.
13. **Dress Code:** All Greater Dayton USBC (GDUSBC) youth bowlers are expected to use good judgment and wear suitable attire during tournament play. Clothing choices must be presentable and non-offensive to other bowlers or spectators. Examples of prohibited attire include but are not limited to: short shorts or any shorts that are more than 4 inches above the knee, pants hanging below the waist, display of underwear and/or body parts, hats, low-cut shirts, see-through clothing, T-shirts with alcohol or cigarette advertisements, inappropriate language, gestures, or gambling. GDUSBC bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by a GDUSBC Tournament Official. Tournament Official's decision will be final. Failure to comply with any dress code rule will result in a verbal warning and apparel change (if applicable). Second offense will result in offender being asked to leave the center for the day, disqualification from the tournament and forfeiture of any entry fees submitted
14. **Conduct:** Tournament Officials may warn or disqualify bowlers for unsportsmanlike or disruptive conduct. There will be a zero tolerance policy for foul language, rude gestures, or abuse of bowling center equipment. Tournament Officials and/or Bowling Center Management may remove any coach or spectator for disruptive conduct and if necessary, suspend them from attending future tournaments.
